Building code of Australia Part 3.3.4.12 - Weatherproofing for single skin masonry walls

(a) A waterproof coating material must be applied to all external single skin masonry walls in accordance with the following:

(i) The coating must extend from the upper most exposed part of the wall -

(A) to a level adjacent the internal finished floor level, if the external blockwork overhangs the edge of the slab 10mm: or

(B) 50mm below the internal floor level if no edge overhang is provided to the blockwork

(ii) Acceptable external weatherproof finishes are -

(A) three coats of acrylic based exterior quality gloss paint: or

(B) one complete coat of cement based paint and two coats of 100% acrylic based exterior quality gloss paint: or

(C) clear water repellent, provided the wall is protected by a roof overhang.
